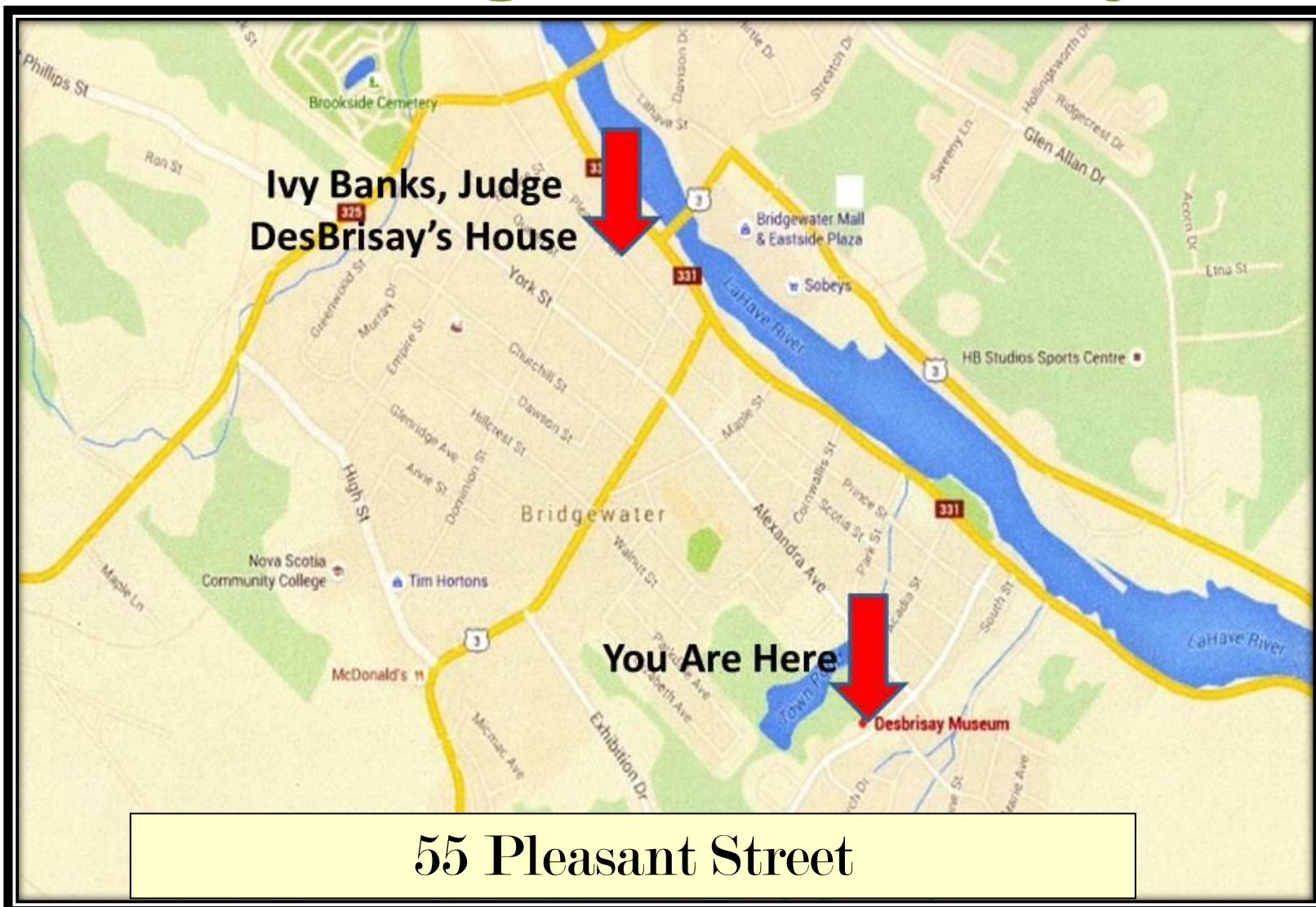


Ivy Banks, Home of Judge DesBrisay



Judge DesBrisay bought this property from his father in law John Harley for \$2000 in 1878. He lived here until 1900, and the parlour of his home became the makeshift museum where he put his interesting artifacts on display for the local people. The house was known as "Ivy Banks."



Judge DesBrisay's house was sold and converted into apartments over the years. The unique trim and verandah have been removed. This is an image of the house today, located on Pleasant Street.
