We welcome submissions from artists of all backgrounds (including but not limited to): Indigenous, Black, people of colour, refugees, newcomers, immigrants, Two-Spirit, LGBTQ+, gender non-binary persons, persons with disabilities, and those on low-incomes or living in poverty. Please advise us of any accommodations needed to ensure you can access and complete the submissions process.

Applications are accepted on an ongoing basis and are evaluated by our Exhibits Committee.

Application Guidelines

Completed application must include:

- Applicant information.
- Names of other participants (if more than one) and their relevance to the exhibit.
- Bio (max. 200 words) or Artist CV for all applicants involved.
- Proposed title of exhibition.
- Brief description of proposed exhibition. (max. 50 words)
- Full description of proposed exhibition, theme or concept, as well as how you plan to use the space, layout, technical, or physical requirements. (max. 500 words)

- Medium, number, and sizes of works you hope to exhibit.
- Images or videos of the work you intend to display. (image files should be .jpg files, 72dpi. Maximum size 1mb)
- Other materials you see fit to accurately explain your exhibit vision
- Description of images, videos, and other supporting materials submitted

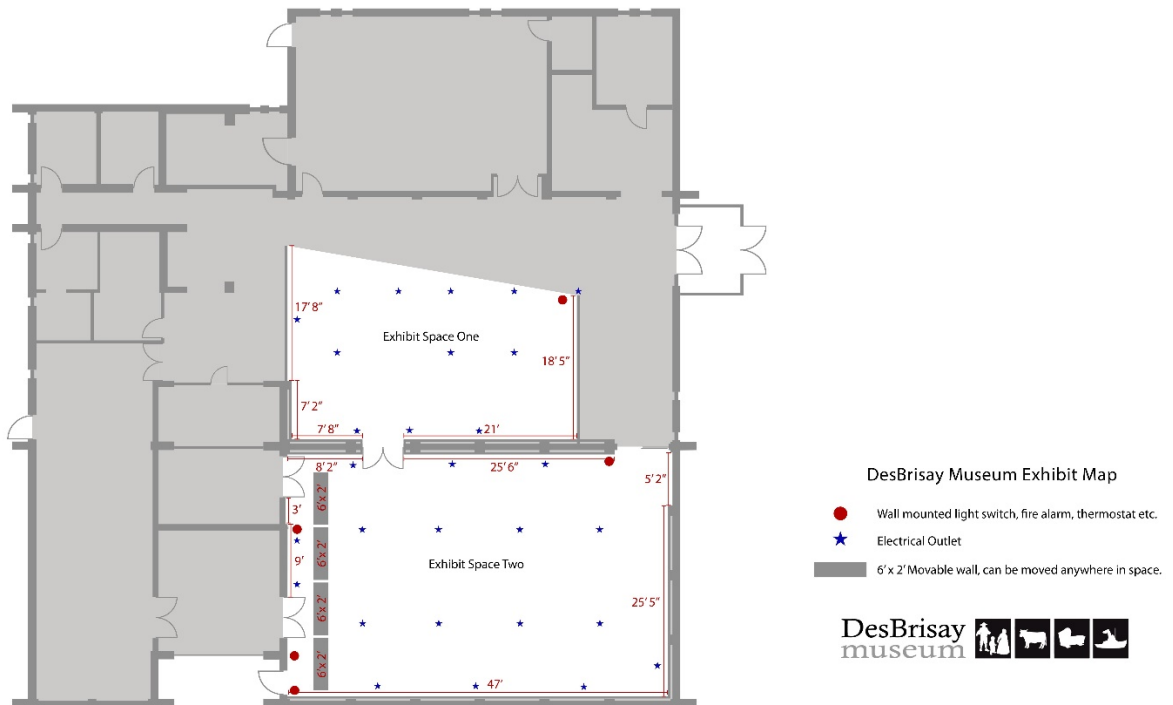
